We take security **VERY** seriously at the credit union so you can be assured that all systems are safe. What we can't guarantee is that you won't be contacted by scammers who are out to steal your personal information and money. It is hard to keep up with all the different ways these bad actors operate. When they call, they often sound very official and can threaten dire consequences if you do not act immediately. Just know that government agencies will never call you at home or ever threaten you. Others will send a legitimate looking e-mail from a company asking to "verify information." Don't open the email, but if it is someone you do business with, reach out



to them with a phone call to see if they sent it. And one of the most heartbreaking scenarios is when fraudsters use a current tragedy to solicit funds for victims. Do your research before donating to anyone. Be smart, don't click and just hang up. Better safe than sorry when dealing with scams.

WATCH OUT FOR THESE COMMON SCAMS:

IRS: Fraudsters call to tell you that you owe back taxes and you had better pay now to avoid jail time.

Social Security: Scammers pretend to be from law enforcement or the SSN administration to "verify" your SSN.

Amazon: The bad guys say your order has been delayed and you should call this phone number to correct the situation.

Microsoft: A call comes from "Tech support" saying your computer has a virus and they can fix it for a hefty fee.

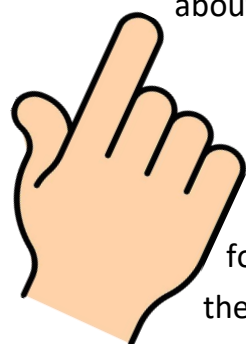
